

CONSTABLE CHRIS GARRETT

MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



Constable Chris Garrett died on May 15th 2004. He was the first officer in the history of the Cobourg Police Services to die in the line of duty.

Ontario's Lieutenant Governor offered this thought at Constable Garrett's funeral... *"This loss reminds us of the risks that police officers face every day as they serve and protect our communities. With their professionalism and bravery, officers like Constable Garrett keep their communities safe."*

It is our hope that this scholarship will help Cobourg students wishing to become law enforcement officers, attain the respect and admiration of their peers and the citizens they serve that Constable Garrett enjoyed.

VALUE: **\$1500.00**

ELIGIBILITY: ***Accepted into a Community College Police Foundations Program the September following the applicant's graduation with the intention of pursuing a career in law enforcement.***

DEADLINE: ***June 1st***



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SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM:

For all students graduating from their final year of high school or have graduated from a Cobourg High School.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- The \$1500 will be allocated in year one of the student's program.
- Applicants must be graduating from their final year of high school or have graduated and have a minimum grade average of 65%.
- Students must also be registered/accepted at a Community College Police Foundations Program the September after graduation.
- In order to qualify for the scholarship, students must send in a completed application form with supporting documentation. Original materials will not be returned. The application deadline is **June 1st**.
- Once students are accepted at the institution of their choice, they must supply us with a copy of their letter of acceptance. Applications will not be processed without this documentation.
- The selection of winners is determined by a committee of Cobourg Rotarians. Selection is based on the points outlined under ELIGIBILITY.

Information may be requested from high school, college, government, or community sources, and may include personal evaluations and transcripts. The information resulting from such request may be used for the scholarship program publicity or promotion purposes.
